

Overview

George Mason University VPN allows you to connect to Mason networks as if you were on campus, making access to restricted services possible. To connect to the VPN from your Windows computer, you need to install the Cisco AnyConnect VPN client.

If Your Computer is on Casper

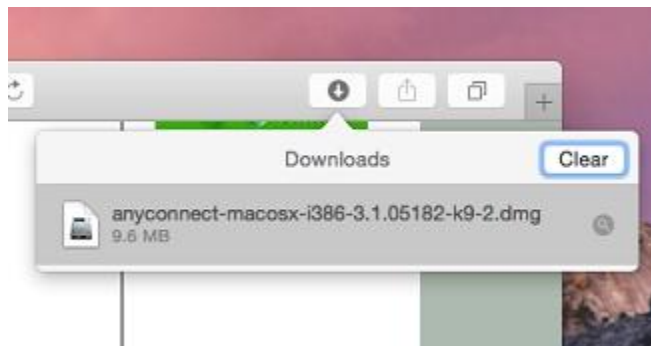
1. All computers on Casper should have the Cisco AnyConnect VPN Client installed. If it is not present in your Applications menu, follow the instructions for those not on Casper.

If Your Computer is NOT on Casper

1. Go to <http://itservices.gmu.edu/downloads/> to download the Cisco AnyConnect VPN client.

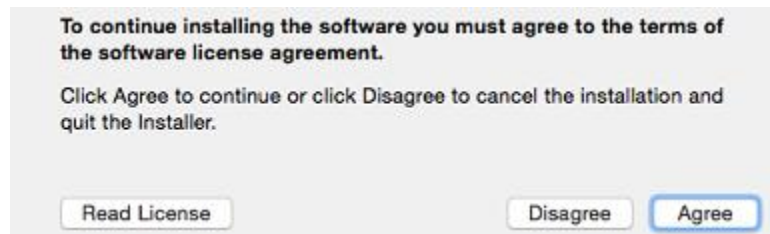
2. Run the downloaded program.



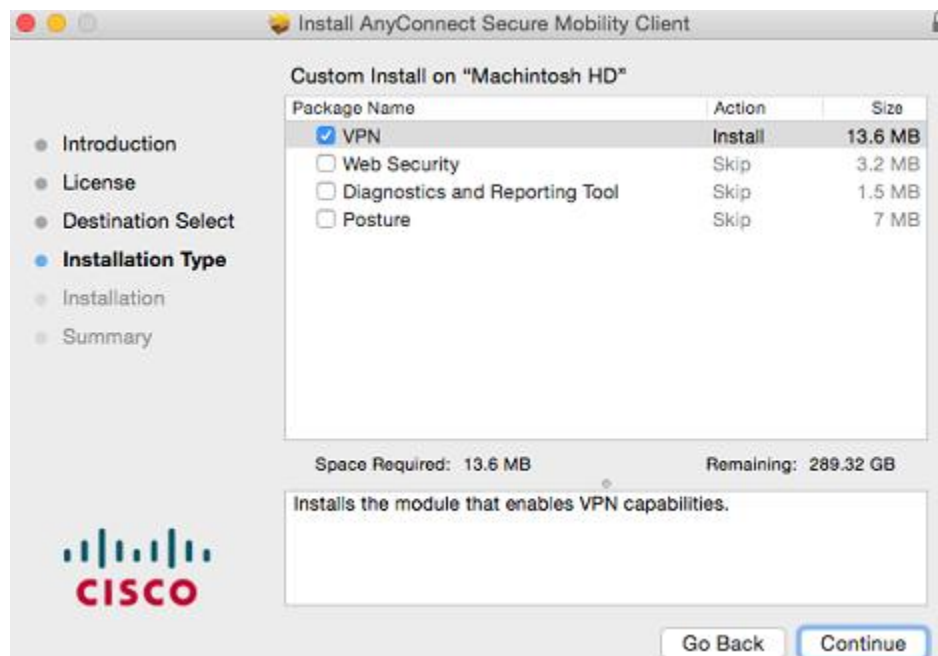
3. When the installation starts, double click **AnyConnect** to continue.



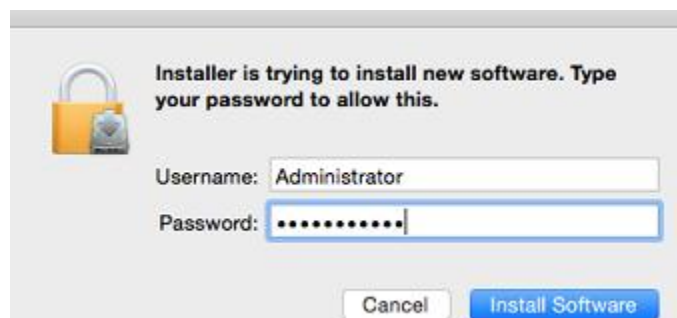
4. Click **Continue** twice.
5. Click **Agree**.



6. **Uncheck** everything except the VPN package.



7. Click **Continue**.
8. Click **Install** to start the installation.
9. If prompted, input your administrator username and password and click **Install Software**.



10. Click **Close** when the installation is complete.
